Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

POLES 123 FT FROM DER, 182 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 30 FT AGL/689 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 91 FT FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100 FT AGL/860 FT MSL.
