

To Subscribers of the Coded Instrument Flight Procedures (CIFP)

The Federal Aviation Administration, AeroNav Products provides the Downloadable Coded Instrument Flight Procedures (DCIFP) to all subscriptions for the Coded Instrument Flight Procedures (CIFP). Subscribers will automatically receive the DCIFP with their CIFP subscription every 28-days. However, the DCIFP will be available for downloading earlier than the CIFP CD-ROM, no later than 16-days prior to the next airspace effective date. Subscribers may download the DCIFP as often as they wish during the cycle. To open the DCIFP, you must use a Zip/UnZip utility program.

If you have an existing e-commerce account, please use the following procedure to access your account:

- 1) Access the Internet and go to: <http://aeronav.faa.gov>
- 2) Click on "Online Ordering" then at the bottom of the left-hand menu.
- 3) Click on the "Log In" button at the top of the page.
- 4) Log in using your established "User ID" and "Password".
- 5) Click on "Account".
- 6) Click on "View Downloadable Products".
- 7) Look for the DCIFP on that page and click the "Download" button on the far right.
When the box appears, click "Save" and then use your UnZip utility program to extract the data.

To create an e-commerce account to purchase the CIFP:

- 1) Access the Internet and go to: <http://aeronav.faa.gov>
- 2) Click on "Online Ordering" at the bottom of the left-hand menu.
- 3) Click on the word "Help" from the menu in the gray box on the left of the screen.
- 4) Scroll to the section entitled, "Establishing An Account" and follow the instructions. Be sure to read the entire section before you begin.
