Subject: Request for Change to the Departure Procedures Route Description via
Abbreviated Amendment (Altitude Change to DRSET on Four KDAL
RNAV SIDs)

The Central Service Center, Operations Support Group, Flight Procedures Team requests approval to amend Dallas Love Field Airport (KDAL) Standard Instrument Departure's SWTSR, CURLO, KKITY and LNDRE, via abbreviated amendment to change the altitude restriction at DRSET from "At or Above" 4,000' to "At or Below" 6,000', to avoid traffic with Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport (KDFW). This requested altitude change impacts the departure procedure's (DPs) route description.

A safety critical issue has been identified by the local and regional Event Review Committees (ERCs) concerning climbing aircraft from KDAL disrupting the overhead flow of larger, heavier jets that departed KDFW. During hot summer months, this can occur up to 120 times a day and needs to be quickly corrected.
