Bearings, headings, courses, tracks and radials are magnetic. Elevation and altitudes are in feet MSL. Altitudes are minimum altitudes unless otherwise indicated.
Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

NOTE: RWY 10, TREES AND BUILDING BEGINNING 150 FT FROM DER, 2 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 115 FT AGL/769 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 329 FT FROM DER, 161 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 115 FT AGL/769 FT MSL.

NOTE: RWY 22, TREES BEGINNING 2376 FT FROM DER, 171 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 103 FT AGL/738 FT MSL. TREES BEGINNING 2138 FT FROM DER, 612 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 101 FT AGL 737 FT MSL.
