Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

TREES BEGINNING 656 FEET FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 50 FEET AGL/449 FEET MSL. BUILDING 309 FEET FROM DER, 100 FEET LEFT OF CENTERLINE 30 FEET AGL/439 FEET MSL. VEHICLES IN PARKING LOT 364 FEET FROM DER, ON CENTERLINE, UP TO 15 FEET AGL/415 FEET MSL.
