

TAKEOFF MINIMUMS AND OBSTACLE DEPARTURE PROCEDURES (ODP)

Bearings, headings, courses, tracks, and radials are magnetic. Elevations and altitudes are in feet, MSL. Altitudes are minimum altitudes unless otherwise indicated. Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated

RWY 13, 18, 31, 36 STANDARD.

NOTE: RWY 36, TREES BEGINNING 242' FROM DER, 466' RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/359' MSL. TREES BEGINNING 1,190' FROM DER, LEFT AND RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/349' MSL.

NOTE RWY 13, TREES 117' FROM DER, 199' RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/359' MSL. TREES 207' FROM DER, 103' LEFT OF CENTERLINE, UP TO 100' AGL/359' MSL. VEHICLE ON ROAD 28' FROM DER, ON CENTERLINE, 15' AGL/265' MSL. (CONT'D)
