Bearings, headings, courses, tracks and radials are magnetic. Elevation and altitudes are in feet MSL. Altitudes are minimum altitudes unless otherwise indicated.
Ceilings are in feet above airport elevation. Distances are in nautical miles. Visibilities are in statute miles or feet RVR unless otherwise indicated.

TAKEOFF MINIMUMS:

RWY 8, 17: STANDARD

RWY 26: STANDARD WITH MINIMUM CLIMB OF 265 FT PER NM TO 4300 OR 900-3 FOR CLIMB IN VISUAL CONDITIONS.

RWY 35: 400-2 OR STANDARD WITH MINIMUM CLIMB OF 250 FT PER NM TO 4000.

TEXTUAL DEPARTURE PROCEDURES:

RWY 26 – FOR CLIMB IN VISUAL CONDITIONS CROSS LEVELLAND MUNI AIRPORT AT OR ABOVE 4400 BEFORE PROCEEDING ON COURSE.

NOTE: RWY 17, VEHICLE ON ROAD 4 FT FROM DER, 387 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, 15 FT AGL/3522 FT MSL. VEHICLE ON ROAD 205 FT FROM DER, 388 FT LEFT OF CENTERLINE, 15 FT AGL/3521 FT MSL. TREE 1291 FT FROM DER, 186 FT RIGHT OF CENTERLINE, 55 FT AGL/3564 FT MSL.
