



VFR Flyway Planning Charts

- ✈ Flyway Planning Charts depict flight paths and altitudes recommended for use to bypass areas heavily traversed by large, turbine-powered aircraft.
- ✈ Select topographic info on these charts provides a guide for visual orientation.
- ✈ Designed for use in conjunction with TACs and are not to be used for navigation.
- ✈ Printed on the reverse sides of the Baltimore-Washington, Charlotte, Chicago, Cincinnati, Dallas-Ft. Worth, Denver, Detroit, Houston, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Miami, Orlando, Phoenix, St. Louis, Salt Lake City, San Diego, San Francisco, and Seattle VFR Terminal Area Charts (TACs).
- ✈ Scale: 1:250,000
- ✈ Updated: Every 6 months (on the corresponding VFR Terminal Area Chart schedule)
