. . . . (transition). Maintain 14000, expect filed altitude within 10 minutes of departure.

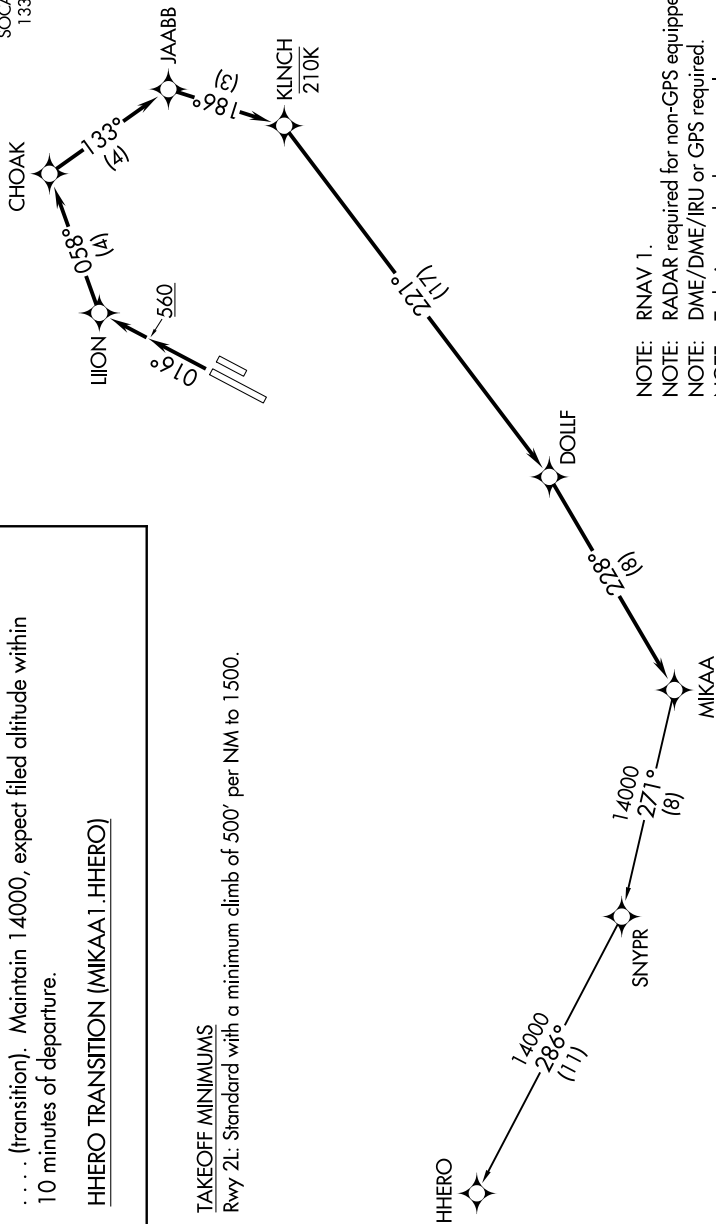
HHERO TRANSITION (MIKAA1.HHERO)

**TAKEOFF MINIMUMS**

Rwy 2L: Standard with a minimum climb of 500' per NM to 1500.



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- NOTE: RNAV 1.
- NOTE: RADAR required for non-GPS equipped aircraft.
- NOTE: DME/DME/IRU or GPS required.
- NOTE: Turbojets and turboprops only.
